7.	Do they now or in the future plan to show their dogs in conformation, obedience, agility, etc? If not shown, what activities are they involved in with their dogs?
8.	Give your opinion on the condition an temperament of their dogs.
9.	Would you sell this person one of your puppies?
10.	Are they willing to sign onto a club committee and eventually work into a board position?
